Dear Parents/Guardians,

Jersey City Public Schools require all students to wear uniforms. PS #16 strictly enforces its uniform policy throughout the year.

Daily Uniform

- **Tops:** Royal blue polo shirts
- **Bottoms:** Khaki pants, shorts, skirts, or jumpers (all must be knee-length and loose-fitting)
- **Leggings/Tights:** Only navy or khaki and/or tights are allowed. No other colors or patterns are permitted.
- **Shorts:** Khaki shorts (knee-length) are allowed in September and June.
- **Sweaters/Hoodies/Cardigans:** Navy blue sweaters, hoodies, and cardigans can be worn while in class. They must be plain or feature the school logo.
 - **Note:** Students can wear any outerwear (sweaters, jackets, or coats) to school, but they must be removed in class.
- **Footwear:** No heels, sandals, or open-toed shoes are allowed. Students must wear appropriate, safe, and comfortable shoes.
- **Gym Uniform:** Mandatory Navy blue t-shirt with the school logo, navy blue sweatpants, and sneakers. Leggings are not allowed in gym class.

Benefits of Wearing a Uniform

The school uniform promotes a sense of community and belonging among students. It also helps maintain a professional and respectful learning environment.

What Happens if the Uniform Policy is Not Followed?

The Main Office will send home a notice and/or contact parents/guardians if a student is not wearing the appropriate uniform.
